



Northridge Knights *Parent/Guardian/Staff Code of Conduct Agreement - 2009*

Purpose:

The purpose of this document is to set forth the expectations for participants, parents, guests, and the staff of the Northridge Knights organization. These areas include behaviors during games and practices, attendance at guest facilities, financial obligations, and the appropriate chain of command in dealing with problems and grievances. Please take a moment to read the following rules.

1. *No use of profanity or abusive language directed toward participants, parents, guests, or staff will be tolerated. Please refer to the problem resolution guidelines should an issue occur.*
2. *No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances are permitted at any game or practice facility used by the Northridge Knights. This includes the parking lots.*
3. *No smoking is allowed on school property.*
4. *Pick up your trash and keep the schools/facilities clean.*
5. *The conduct of any guests brought to the practice or game facilities is the responsibility of the parent/guardian of the participant and parents/guardians are expected to monitor the activities of these siblings/guests/etc.*
6. *All financial obligations to the Knights should be satisfied in a timely manner. Please honor your commitments to pay all fees on time and help the Club run smoothly.*
7. *Parents/Guardians are not allowed on the field during practices and games. In addition, do not interfere with the coaching activities in progress.*
8. *The Northridge Knights is a volunteer organization and no one is paid. Please treat all staff with respect and consideration; they work very hard to provide a good program for you.*
9. *If an issue arises, please observe the procedure outlined below.*

Problem Resolution Process:

1. Calmly present the issue to the manager or cheer mom. Try to be as objective as possible.
2. If the problem remains unresolved, *with the manager/cheer mom*, discuss the issue with the appropriate NAC Staff member. [Athletic Director (football coaching), the General Manager (manager/player), or the Cheer Director (cheerleading).]
3. The NAC staff members above will attempt to resolve the issue or recommend further action.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in the offender being asked to leave the premises and could result in forfeiture of a game. Serious and/or repeated offenses could result in expulsion from the Northridge Athletic Club.
